### Kweisi Mfume and the 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Race

If you live in the 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District (formerly Elijah Cummings' district) and you're registered to vote in this district, you will automatically receive a ballot for this election in the mail. **Your ballot must be completed and postmarked on or before Tuesday, April 28, 2020.**

If you're registered at the **wrong address or not registered**, use the link above to make changes. The Board of Elections must receive your request by:

**Tuesday, April 21, 2020** if you want your ballot mailed to a different address

**Friday, April 24, 2020** if you want to download your ballot from the State's website

### June 2, 2020 Maryland Primary Election Deadlines

The state is quickly finalizing the plan for this election. It appears that all registered Maryland voters will automatically receive a ballot in the mail. **YOUR BALLOT MUST BE COMPLETED AND POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE PRIMARY ELECTION DAY (Tuesday, June 2, 2020).**

If you're registered at the **wrong address or not registered**, use the link above to make changes. The Board of Elections must receive your request by:

**TENTATIVE DEADLINE: Tuesday, May 26, 2020** if you want to receive your ballot by mail

**TENTATIVE DEADLINE: Friday, May 29, 2020** if you want to download your ballot from the State's website
