## Kweisi Mfume and the 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Race

If you live in the 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District (formerly Elijah Cummings' district) and you're registered to vote in this district, you will <u>automatically</u> receive a ballot for this election in the mail. Your ballot must be completed and **postmarked on or before Tuesday, April 28, 2020.** 

<u>If you're registered at the **wrong address or not registered**, use the link above to make changes. <u>The Board of</u> <u>Elections must receive your request by:</u></u>

Tuesday, April 21, 2020 if you want your ballot mailed to a different address

Friday, April 24, 2020 if you want to download your ballot from the State's website

## June 2, 2020 Maryland Primary Election Deadlines

The state is quickly finalizing the plan for this election. It appears that all registered Maryland voters will automatically receive a ballot in the mail. <u>YOUR BALLOT MUST BE COMPLETED AND POSTMARKED ON OR</u> <u>BEFORE PRIMARY ELECTION DAY (Tuesday, June 2, 2020).</u>
